

Fall 2024 FAMU Feeder Fellowship Application Deadline: Friday, March 1, 2024

The Florida A&M University (FAMU) Feeder Program is a partnership between FAMU and UF that supports FAMU students admitted to master's or Ph.D. programs at UF. The program aims to increase the number of FAMU students in graduate programs. UF offers fellowships yearly to FAMU Feeder students admitted to Ph.D., master's, or MFA programs. Participating departments provide FAMU Feeder students with at least a 0.5 FTE research or teaching assistantship (RA/TA) and health insurance for the first three years. Ph.D. students receive a \$13,000 stipend, tuition, and fees for the first three years. Master's students receive \$3,500 for fall and spring semesters for four semesters and must be on-campus students. Participating departments provide an RA/TA at the 0.5 FTE rate for the fourth and fifth years and cover tuition, fees, and health insurance.

Required materials: Your application package must include...

- This form, completely filled out on both sides.
- Your unofficial transcripts.
- A copy of your official UF graduate admission acceptance letter. (Applications can be submitted before you receive your acceptance letter, but a decision on your application will not be made until your UF graduate admission has been verified.)
- Your personal statement (see next page for instructions).
